Just Saying . . .

Most everyone is familiar with the song, "The Twelve Days of Christmas" I believe. To most it's a delightful nonsense rhyme set to music. But it has a purpose that is quite serious, especially during the time it was written.

"Just saying," it is a great deal more than just a repetitious melody with pretty phrases and a list of what may appear to be strange gifts.

During the period 1558 to 1829, individuals were prohibited from any practice of their faith by law in private or public, because it was a crime to practice Catholicism¹.

"The Twelve Days of Christmas" was written in England as one of the "catechism songs" to help young Catholic confirmands learn the tenets of their faith – as a memory aid.

The gifts of the song have hidden meanings for the teachings of the faith. The "true love" mentioned in the song doesn't refer to an earthly popular internet match, it refers to God Himself. The "me" who receives the presents refers to every baptized person.

A partridge in a pear tree = Jesus Christ, the Son of God. In the song, Christ is symbolically presented as a mother partridge nestled in a pear tree, saddened over the fate of Jerusalem.

2 Turtle Doves = The Old and New Testaments

3 French Hens = Faith, Hope and Charity, the Theological Virtues

4 Calling Birds = the Four Gospels and/or the Four Evangelists

5 Golden Rings = The first Five Books of the Old Testament, the "Pentateuch", which gives the history of man's fall from grace.

6 Geese A-laying = the six days of creation

7 Swans A-swimming = the seven gifts of the Holy Spirit, the seven sacraments

8 Maids A-milking = the eight beatitudes

9 Ladies Dancing = the nine Fruits of the Holy Spirit

10 Lords A-leaping = the ten commandments

11 Pipers Piping = the eleven faithful apostles

12 Drummers Drumming = the twelve points of doctrine in the Apostle's Creed

My hope is that each time you sing, hear or discuss the "Twelve Days of Christmas" one may hear the song with fresh ears, and sing it with a renewed voice and discuss it with reflection that brings glory to Jesus Christ. Christ is the gift of love to the world; **remembering to share love, "we can give without love, but we cannot love with giving!"**

I pray that as we go forward that we go forward together with that love in ministry to build a life of unity for the community of Christ, casting ourselves aside, prepared to receive fresh words as God speaks.

Have a fun, safe and enjoyable holiday, taking a moment during the 12 days of Christmas to think of Christ!

Women's Winter Renewal Retreat

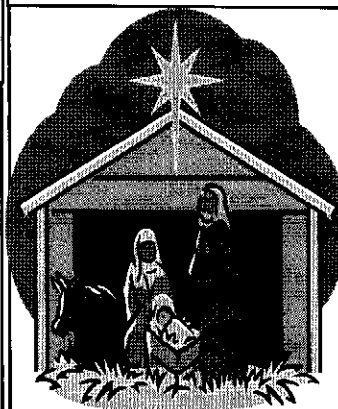

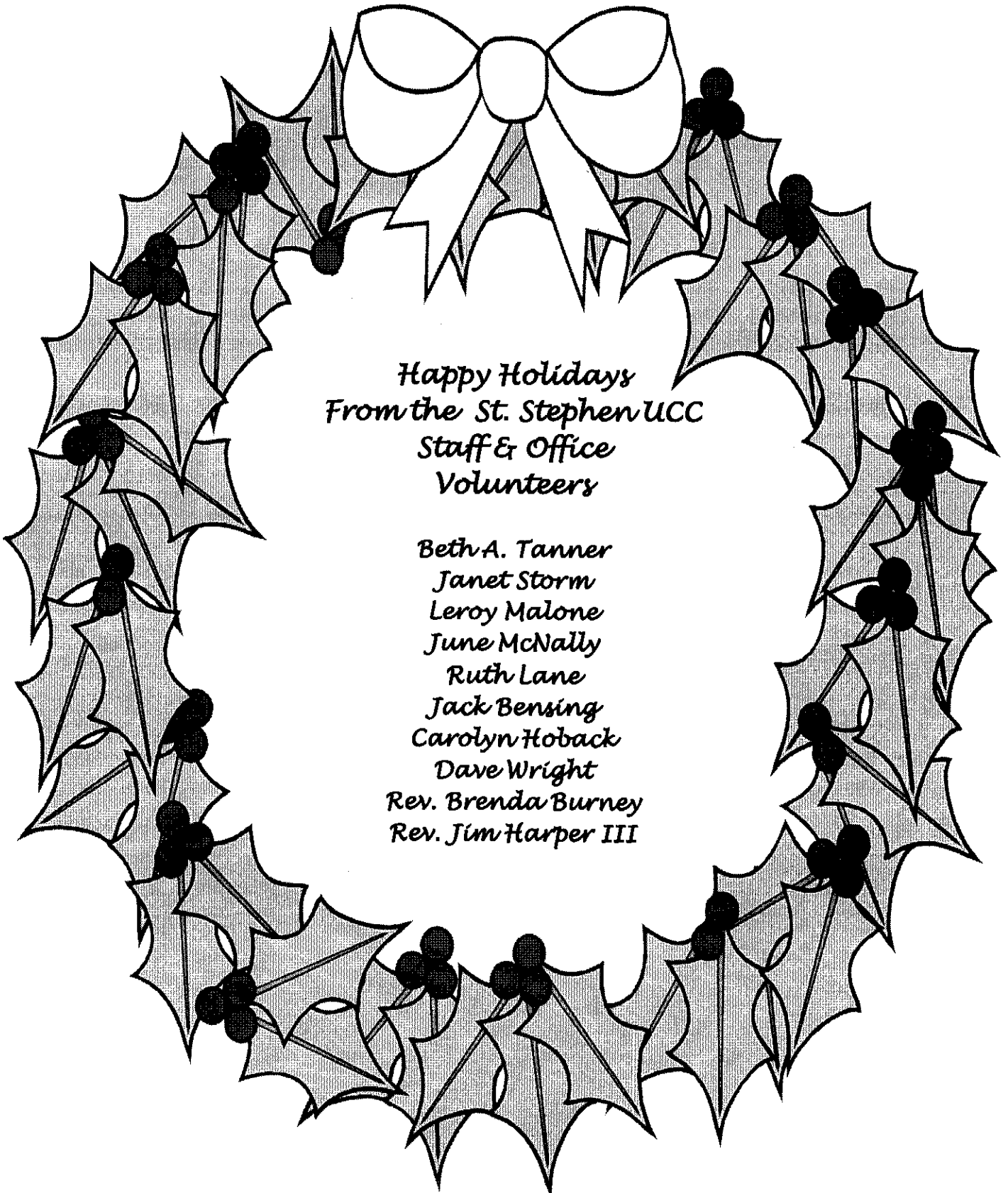

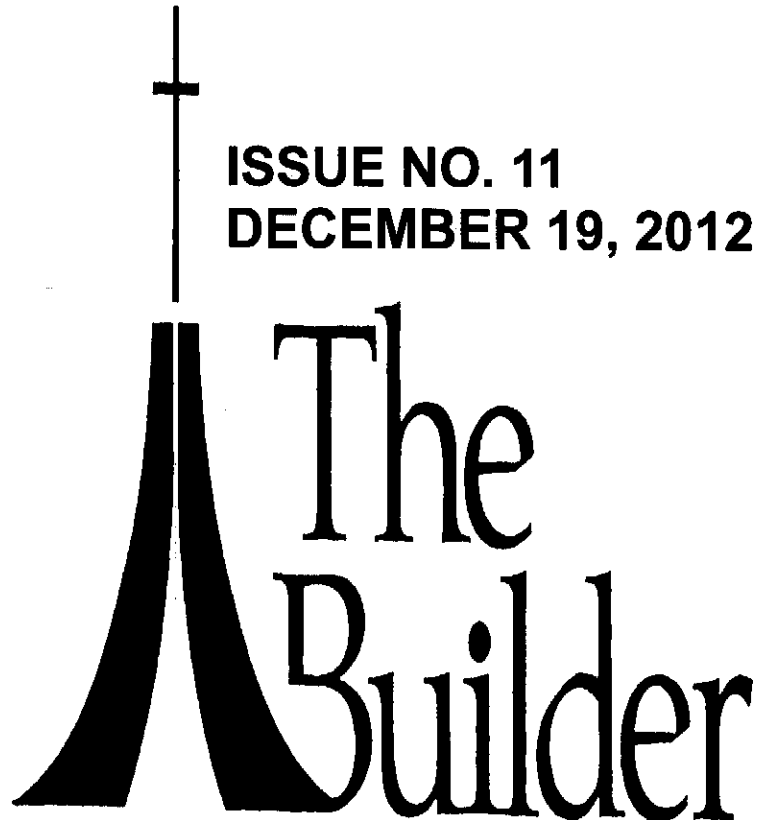
