Imagine, for more than a moment with me, being in a compromised medical situation, being transient, and having no place to lay your head. How would you want other people to engage with you, if this was your present situation in life? It is romantic for us now to close our eyes and picture a pregnant woman, an older man and donkey all traveling together. We do it every year. We call it a beautiful picture of faith, because we know how the story ends: mom fine, dad relieved, baby born and placed in the hay, cattle lowing and the whole scene glowing in our radiant imaginations and projections of the story that is so much apart of faith rituals and traditions.

The problem is that the story of being in a compromised medical situation and no place to lay her head was not sterile and sanitized. It had to be full of anxiety and discomfort, as well as uncertainties galore. Anxiety, discomfort and uncertainties seem to be what life is all about for so many people these days. None of us have to go too far to find someone who is in a compromised position. It could be financially. It might be medically. It might be emotionally. It might even be a difficult situation of having no place to lay their head. In each of these or all of these, we can also find Christ. Dorothy Day shared some words on this subject when she wrote:

“It is no use saying that we are born two thousand years too late to give room to Christ. Nor will those who live at the end of the world have been born too late. Christ is always with us, always asking for room in our hearts.

But now it is with the voice of our contemporaries that he speaks, with the eyes of store clerks, factory workers and children that he gazes; with the hands of office workers, slum dwellers and suburban housewives that he gives. It is with the feet of soldiers and tramps that he walks, and with the heart of anyone in need that he longs for shelter. And giving shelter or food to anyone who asks for it, or needs it, is giving it to Christ.

If we hadn't got Christ's own words for it, it would seem raving lunacy to believe that if I offer a bed and food and hospitality to some man or woman or child, my guest is Christ. There is nothing to show it, perhaps. There are no halos already glowing round their heads -- at least none that human eyes can see. (Dorothy Day, "Room for Christ," in *Watch for the Light: Readings for Advent and Christmas* (Plough Publishing House, 2001), 179-181.)

Christ is in us and Christ is among us; it is up to us to make sure the connection of Christ happens where it is needed the most. Pray for the compromised, and pray that Christ will meet Christ, and that you too will be present to witness it this season of Advent and Christmas.
