In her autobiography, *My Story*, Marilyn Monroe told how it felt to be abandoned by her parents. Her father had abandoned them when Marilyn was born--so Marilyn never knew him--but she saw a picture of him on her mother's wall. Her father was handsome. He looked like Clark Gable. Norma Jean--that was Marilyn's childhood name--would walk home from school in the rain, daydreaming that her father would be waiting for her--and that he would scold her for not wearing her rubber boots in the rain. But, of course, that never happened. She yearned for someone who really cared about her--but no one did.

Norma Jean's mother did the best she could, but she had to work and couldn't take care of little Norma Jean, so she paid people to take care of her. Then one day her mother managed to get a little house--a white house with a back yard. There was even an old piano for Norma Jean to play. An English couple moved in to take care of her.

But then there was a terrible commotion--bangs and thuds that kept on and on and on. It was Norma Jean's mother, who was screaming and laughing and making all kinds of noise. Some people came and took the mother to a mental hospital--and some other people came to take Norma Jean to an orphanage.

Norma Jean had always felt unloved--and her life had always been bleak--but daydreaming had always been her escape. In a daydream, she could be anyone. In a daydream, anything could happen. In a daydream, she could have people who loved her.

But after they took her mother away, for a long time Norma Jean found that she could no longer daydream.

Norma Jean lived in nine foster homes in the next few years. She finally escaped by getting married at age sixteen. It had been a brutal childhood, because she had been abandoned--purposely by her father and for health reasons by her mother. Abandoned!

There are millions of people out there who have experienced pain, sorrow, grief, neglect, abuse and abandonment. It's terrible and life can be terrible for so many. But one thing that we are all promised is that God will never abandon us, even in the midst of the most painful life situations.

Lamentations 3: 19-24/It's a Good Thing to Hope for Help from God

*19-21 I'll never forget the trouble, the utter lostness,
the taste of ashes, the poison I've swallowed.
I remember it all--oh, how well I remember--
the feeling of hitting the bottom.*

*But there's one other thing I remember,
and remembering, I keep a grip on hope:*

*22-24 God's loyal love couldn't have run out,
his merciful love couldn't have dried up.*

They're created new every morning.

How great your faithfulness!

I'm sticking with God (I say it over and over).

He's all I've got left.

God is always faithful!"

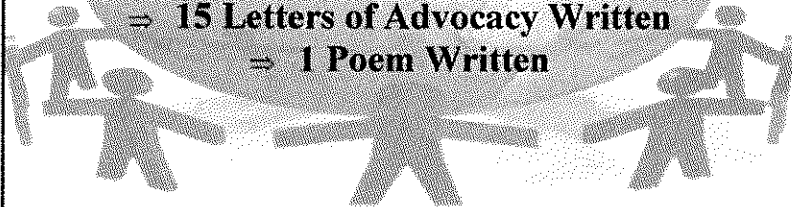

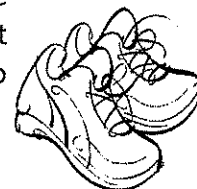


