- *Seven people from St. Stephen went to the halfway house for women for a worship service. The women were appreciative for the service and those from the church that attended found the experience to be very rewarding.

- *Facilities Management - We have several trees that need to be trimmed. One of them borders the property line with Summerfield Rehab and is in the way of their sign. Air conditioning in some part of the building (nursery area) is not working properly. With cooler weather approaching we hope to put this expense off until next spring.
- *Volunteers are needed to work the Chili Fest and for pricing the items for the yard sale.

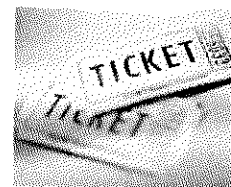

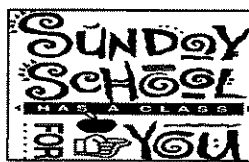

Through UCCTakeAction.org, our national Justice and Witness Ministries office offers resources, news updates, and action alerts on a broad spectrum of justice issues. Working with members of the UCC Justice and Peace Action Network (a network of thousands of UCC justice and peace advocates), Justice and Witness continues its strong policy advocacy work on issues such as the federal budget, voting rights, immigration, health care, hate crimes, civil liberties, and environmental justice. Neighbors in Need also supports our American Indian Ministries (CAIM). Historically, forebears of the UCC established churches and worked with Lakota, Dakota, Nakota, Mandan, Hidatsa, Arickara, and Hocak in North and South Dakota, Wisconsin, and northern Nebraska. Today there are 20 UCC congregations on reservations and one urban, multi-tribal UCC congregation in Minneapolis, Minnesota. These churches and their pastors are supported by CAIM. CAIM is also an invaluable resource for more than 1,000 individuals from dozens of other tribes and nations who are member of other UCC congregations in the U.S.

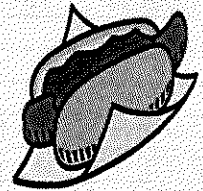
